

**PUBLIC MEETING – THURSDAY, 22 FEBRUARY 2018, 6 PM  
PROPOSED PLAN FOR MCGUIRE BOMARC SITES AND  
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD MEETING, 7:00 PM**

**PROPOSED PLAN ISSUED FOR THREE SITES AT FORMER BOEING MICHIGAN AERONAUTICAL  
RESEARCH CENTER (BOMARC) AT JOINT BASE MCGUIRE-DIX-LAKEHURST**

The Department of the Air Force and Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL) invite public comment on the Proposed Plan for three sites at the former BOMARC facility—Site OT016 (trichloroethene groundwater plume), WP005 (Missile site JP-X Discharge Pit), and ST015 (Missile Site Motor Oil/Gasoline Underground Storage Tank). The BOMARC facility opened in the late 1950s to provide surface to air interception capability along the East Coast of the United States; the facility ceased use in 1972. Environmental studies have found groundwater and soil at ST015 meet regulatory standards for protection of human health and the environment, and No Further Action is proposed. The Air Force evaluated four remediation alternatives for Sites OT016 and WP005 and is proposing a combination of air sparging, natural attenuation, monitored natural attenuation, and land use controls. This alternative would actively remediate and monitor groundwater and monitor surface water until remedial goals are met.

The public is encouraged to review and provide written or verbal comments on the Proposed Plan during the 30-day comment period (18 February to 19 March 2018). The final remedy will be selected after the public comment period has closed, and all comments have been taken into consideration.
