PROPOSED PLAN ISSUED FOR DIX SITE NW042 AT JOINT BASE MCGUIRE-DIX-LAKEHURST

The Department of the Air Force and Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL) invite public comment on the Proposed Plan for Dix Site NW042. The Site is a former housing area and is approximately 40 acres; it is located adjacent to the Pemberton Gate along the installation's southern boundary which is within the Pineland Protection Area. Environmental investigations identified 2,420 cubic yards of pesticide-impacted soil. The Air Force evaluated four remediation alternatives for the Site: no action; in-situ soil mixing; excavation and off-site disposal; and ex-situ soil treatment. The Air Force is recommending in-situ soil mixing as the preferred alternative. This alternative would reduce the overall concentrations of pesticides to below New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection residential direct contact standards.

Copies of the Proposed Plan are available for review beginning Sunday, 3 March 2019, at the Burlington County Library located at 5 Pioneer Blvd., Westampton, NJ, and at the NJDEP Records Custodian, 401 East State Street, Trenton, NJ. The public is encouraged to review and provide written or verbal comments on the Proposed Plan during the 30-day comment period (3 March to 2 April 2019). Comments must be postmarked by 2 April 2019 and sent to Mr. Curtis Frye, Chief, Environmental Restoration Program, 787 CES/CEIE, 2403 Vandenberg Avenue, JB MDL, NJ, 08641 or by email to curtis.frye@us.af.mil or by fax to 609.754.2096. The final remedy will be selected after the public comment period has closed, and all comments have been taken into consideration.

RESTORATION ADVISORY MEETING – PUBLIC INVITED TO ATTEND

The RAB meeting will immediately follow the public meeting, starting at approximately 6:45 p.m. and ending at approximately 8:00 p.m. The RAB meeting provides an update on JB MDL environmental restoration projects. Discussion topics will include the remedial design/remedial action for the BOMARC site, update on the planned removal action at OU-3, and an update on overall progress of the basewide performance-based remediation contract.


