

The Department of the Air Force and Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL) invite public comment on the Proposed Plan for three sites at the McGuire Operable Unit 1 (two soil-capped landfills referred to as Sites LF003 and LF004 and a former Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office Storage Facility referred to as Site ST007) to address contaminated soil and groundwater. The Air Force evaluated four remediation alternatives and is proposing a combination of soil covers, land use controls, and long-term monitoring of groundwater. This alternative would provide protection and monitoring while causing less disturbance to the sites than clear cutting and installing full caps.
