PUBLIC NOTICE JOINT BASE MCGUIRE-DIX-LAKEHURST

Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL), in coordination with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), has initiated a five-year review of existing decision documents and ongoing environmental cleanup activities at the following two JB MDL-McGuire sites, located within the inactive Boeing Michigan Aeronautical Research Center (BOMARC). The two sites to be evaluated include Site OT016 - Trichloroethylene (TCE) Groundwater Plume and Site WP005 - Missile Site JP-X Discharge Pit. The five-year review will be conducted pursuant to Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act §121 (c).

The purpose of the five-year review is to assess whether remedial actions performed at sites OT016 and WP005 continue to be protective of human health and the environment. The methods, findings, and conclusions of the review will be documented in a Five-Year Review Report. The report will identify any issues found during the review and propose recommendations to address them. The final report will be made public in January 2025.
